Joining fee for new members: R200

Membership fee: R500 annually (only main member of the family pays)

Senior members 60+: R200.00

Members joining after 1 July, pay full joining fee and half of the annual fee.

Visitors: R100 per shooter per hour or part thereof.

Student visitors 16+: R50 / hr (Proof of student status required or else pay R100)

Children 16 and under shoot free (if paying parent / care-taker is shooting too).

Pensioners who were members for the past 3 years - free

Unpaid members will lose membership on 1 March 2020 – Joining fee will apply if renewal is then requested.

Please Note!

- ❖ **All persons shooting at the range MUST have their firearm licences with them for inspection.**
- ❖ **Range access will only be allowed when a Blesbok qualified Range Officer is on duty.**
- ❖ **The Range is available on Saturday, Sunday and all public holidays.**
 - *Arrangements must be made with the Range Office before the Thursday evening to ensure that he/she will be available for range duty. If no arrangements were made, the RO would be under no obligation to open the range.*
- ❖ **Shooters to arrange for a range officer to open the range on public holidays**
- ❖ **Familiarise yourself with the Range Safety Rules**
